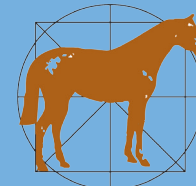

Dr le Jeune is a board-certified specialist in the American College of Veterinary Sports Medicine and Rehabilitation (ACVSMR).

She also obtained certification in veterinary chiropractic treatment by the International Veterinary Chiropractic Association.
